1 DEFINITIONS

1.1 "Company" means a business entity registered as **Alexander Stoyan** in Canada (Ontario).

1.2 "You" means a user of this web-site.

2 PRINCIPLES

It is the policy of the Company to control the collection, use, and disclosure of personal information in accordance with all requirements set out in the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act, S.C. 2000, c. 5. The Company will comply with the following principles unless exempted by the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act.

2.1 Identifying Purposes

The Company shall identify the purposes for which personal information is collected at or before the time the information is collected.

2.2 Consent

2.3 Limiting Collection

2.5 Accuracy

2.6 Safeguards

Personal information shall be protected by security safeguards appropriate to the sensitivity of the information.

2.7 Openness

The Company shall make readily available to individuals specific information about its policies and practices relating to the management of personal information.
